


#### CONTINUED GROWTH.

### CENTER FOR BUSINESS GROWTH

#### \$13 MILLION IN NEW GRANTS TO THE REGION

- New aerospace company Presque Isle




### **BROADBAND INITIATIVES**

NMDC hosts two broadband initiative employees on-site, including one through a partnership with the National Digital Equity Center.

Together with our partnering Digital Navigator, we bridge access to over 30 course topics available, both at physical locations in Aroostook County and taught live online on a monthly basis.

Along with this, municipalities can work directly with our broadband planning team to help them prepare for broadband funding rollouts, and to help their residents become better connected.


#### **AFFORDABLE HOUSING RESOURCES**

We are committed to bridging the housing gap in Aroostook County. In 2024 we released our Affordable Housing Toolkit to municipal stakeholders, businesses, and other interested individuals and organizations to empower their communities to think about the future of housing.

This toolkit is designed to guide conversations about local housing policy, and help provide an understanding how government decisions directly impact housing affordability. It addresses comprehensive planning, land use regulations and zoning, and identifies potential funding sources for creating affordable housing.

Together with the Aroostook Partnership, we continued this pledge by assisting in organizing the Aroostook County Housing Development Conference in May 2024, bringing partners together to create real solutions to housing shortages.





#### VILLAGE PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVE

In partnership with Maine DOT, Caribou, Presque Isle, Van Buren, Madawaska, and Fort Kent, we are identifying ways to improve safety & accessibility for all forms of transportation, while improving Northern Maine's transportation infrastructure in downtown regions. This study will not only consider roadway safety & mobility issues, but also improve transit in the region.

With each individual community comes their own look, feel, and character of their downtowns. This project allows municipalities to keep their image, while accessing funding and guidance for future improvements to their infrastructure.

### **REGIONAL CODE ENFORCEMENT**

NMDC will partner with Maine Emergency Management Agency and Kennebec Valley Council of Governments to create a pilot program to place a regional Code Enforcement Officer (CEO) into their organizations. This position would be an NMDC employee and provide participating municipalities with the necessary expertise to handle code enforcement, along with working with stakeholders, agencies, and landowners to administer necessary codes, regulations, & statutes. This program will assist communities without dedicated CEO staff to create stronger comprehensive plans and allow them to tackle greater issues utilizing this new office hosted at NMDC.



#### **BUDGET INCREASES ALLOW ACT TO PROVIDE GREATER SERVICES**

We are proud to continue to provide the services of Aroostook County Tourism (ACT) to stakeholders free of charge! Our organization is led by a 13-person volunteer board, along with two part-time program staff members.

We are excited to note that this year, the Maine Office of Tourism has provided \$250,000 toward marketing Aroostook County, marking a 114% increase in the operating budget since 2020. With these funds, we will reframe the way information is shared with visitors & stakeholders to create a truly unique experience!

#### **VISITATION NUMBERS ARE UP**

With a 17.5 increase in overall visitation, Aroostook County is continuing to grow it's base of dedicated visitors to the region.

This year alone, visitors have directly spent nearly **\$170** million in the region, with an economic impact of over **\$255** million!

### LOOK FOR OUR NEW CONTENT

This year, we've reframed and built new Visit Aroostook content, including planning the launch of our new website dedicated to re-engaging with businesses and stakeholders, empowering them to highlight their businesses through our content & messaging.

### 2024 ECLIPSE

ACT facilitated open forums for area businesses and organizations to plan for the eclipse, including connecting State and Federal resources with municipalities to ensure a safe event!

In partnership with 6 Aroostook communities and 19 designated eclipse viewing Star Parks, we promoted the region as the premiere destination for the 2024 Solar Eclipse, bringing an estimated 20,000 visitors to the region.

Featuring a filled room with government officials, and the banking and construction industries, the group convened to determine how to best tackle the issue of housing in the region, along with showcasing the achievements of the regional partners who are creating solutions.



#### **LEADERSHIP AROOSTOOK GRADUATES 13**

Continuing the partnership with Husson University and other local employers, 13 graduates of the Leadership Aroostook program were recognized in May 2024. Graduates collaboratively tackled both housing and transportation challenges in the region, creating foundations for government officials and future Leadership Aroostook classes to utilize.
